#### Notes

Sergeant Frankel was a member of Company K, 3rd Battalion, 32nd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division. He was Killed in Action while fighting the enemy in the Battle of Triangle Hill (598), Kumhwa, North Korea on October 18, 1952. His remains were not recovered. His name is inscribed on the Courts of the Missing at the Honolulu Memorial.

Awards: Sergeant Frankel was awarded the Purple Heart, the Combat Infantryman Badge, the Korean Service Medal, the United Nations Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the Korean Presidential Unit Citation and the Republic of Korea War Service Medal.
