ACTIVITIES: Archery.

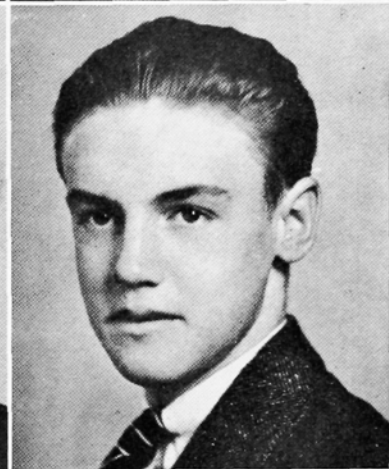
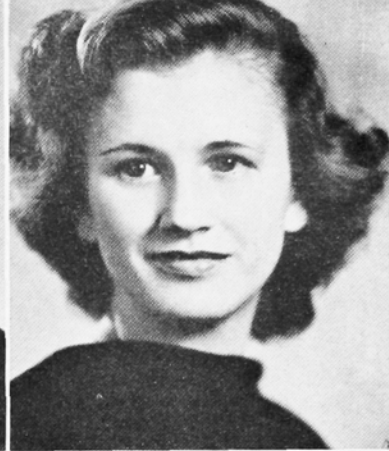
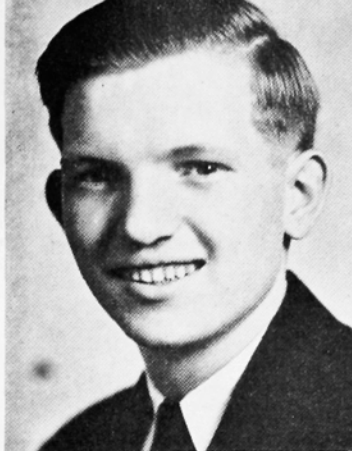
