TEANECK — **Pfc. Richard Brenner**, 21, of 523 Maitland Ave., was killed Sunday in Vietnam, the Defense Department announced yesterday.

A former member of the Teaneck High School track team, Mrs. Brenner last year dropped out of Northland College in Ashland, Wis.

He was drafted and was sent Home, to Vietnam in January.

His sister, Sandy, described him as a happy-go-lucky person who seemed very out of place in Vietnam.

"I can't tell you what he wanted to be," Miss Brenner said.

Pfc. Richard Brenner said. "He just wanted to be happy and grown up. Like everybody wants to be." Miss Brenner did not know the details of his death.

He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Harold Brenner; a brother, Sidney, and his sister.
