

Robert Martin, Noted Artist

RIDGEFIELD — A requiem mass for Robert J. Martin will be tomorrow at 10 a.m. in St. Matthew's R. C. Church. Burial will be in Gate of Heaven Cemetery, Mt. Pleasant, N.Y.

Mr. Martin died Tuesday at his home at 616 Sketch Place. He was 83.

A native of New York City, he lived here more than 45 years.

An artist, his works have been exhibited in the Brooklyn Museum, in Los Angeles, Boston, Philadelphia, and Newark, and in several private collections.

In 1936 he designed 14 stained-glass windows for the chapel at Fort Dix. The windows, each 4 by 8 feet, are believed to be the only ones of their kind in an Army fort chapel. He painted murals for the Ford Exposition at the 1939 World's Fair in New York.

Surviving are two nieces and two nephews.
