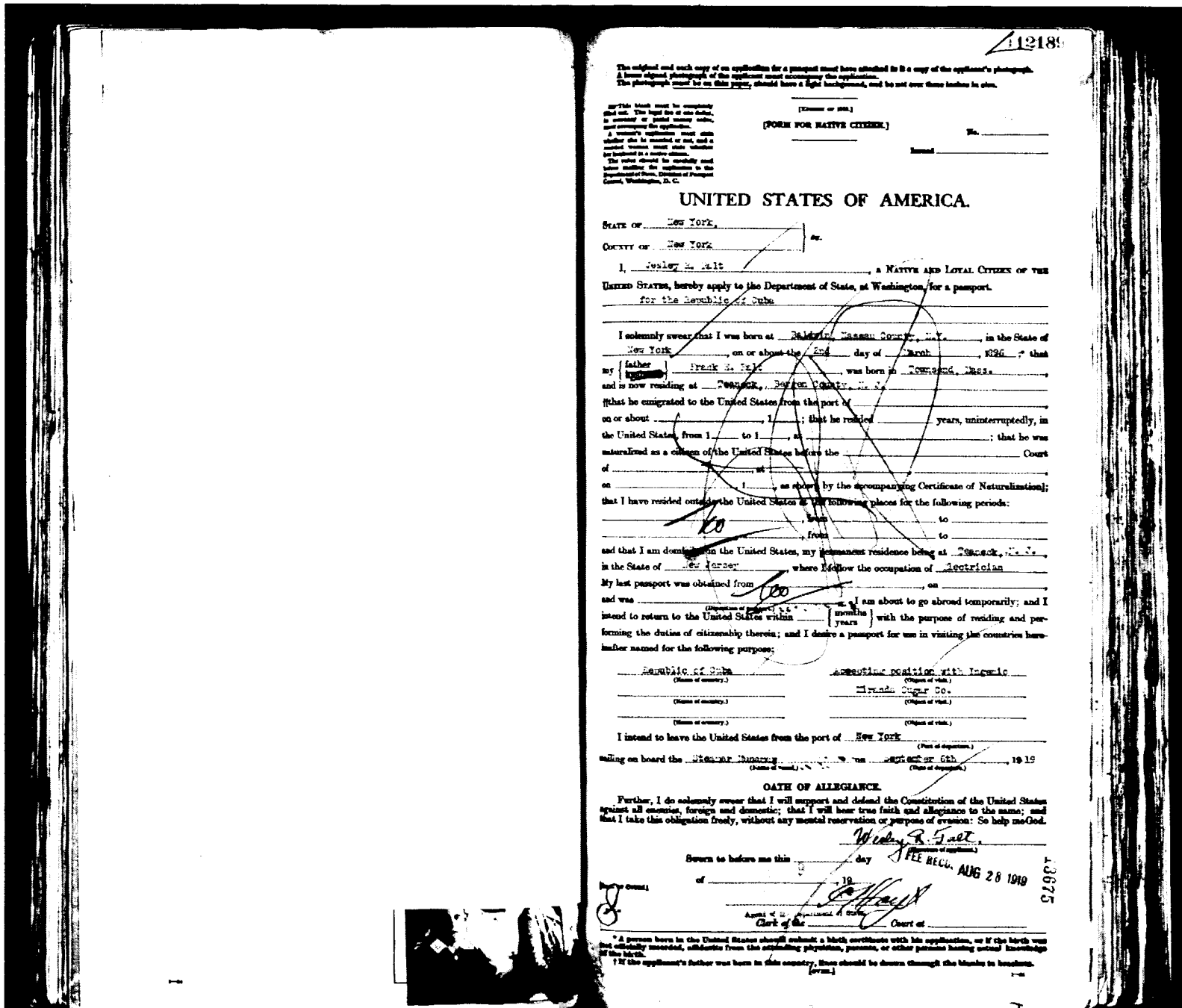

**Description:**

This is a collection of American passport applications that includes passport applications from 1795-1925, passport amendment and extension applications from 1912-1925, and a register of passport applications that cover most of the same years. Passport applications often include information regarding an applicant's family status, date and place of birth, residence, naturalization (if foreign-born), and other biographical information. Twentieth-century applications often include marriage and family information as well as dates, places, and names of ships used for travel.

The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A loose signed photograph of the applicant must accompany the application. The photograph must be on this page, should have a light background, and be set over these lines in place.

The blank must be completely filled out. The legal sex of an infant, as ascertained by birth records, shall accompany the application. A minor's application must state whether she is married or not, and a married woman must state whether her husband is a native citizen. The rules should be carefully read before making the application to the Department of State, Division of Passport Control, Washington, D. C.
