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ANDREW F. OPPELT SR., 91, of Bogota died yesterday. Before retiring 26 years ago, he was a postal clerk for the U.S. Post Office in New York City. An Army veteran of World War I, he was cofounder and second commander of American Legion Post 128, Teaneck. He was a member of Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1616, Teaneck, and the Retired Federal Employees Association. He also was head usher at St. Anastasia's R.C. Church, Teaneck, for more than 40 years. Surviving are two sons, Andrew F. Jr. of Wilmington, N.C., and Robert T. of St. Petersburg, Fla.; a brother, Joseph J. of Teaneck; seven grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren. His wife, Gertrude E. Davison Oppelt, died in 1983. Mass will be said Friday at 10 a.m. at St. Anastasia's Church, with burial in Maryrest Cemetery, Mahwah.
