ROBERT M. CAFARELLI

Robert M. Cafarelli was born on July 5, 1923 to Nicholas and Sophia A. Cafarelli of North Bergen, New Jersey. He enrolled in Saint Peter's College where he attended for two years from 1940 – 1941. On April 5, 1943 he enlisted in the United States Army and became a Technician, Fifth Grade with the 4th Information and Historical Unit at the 9th Army Headquarters.

On January 10, 1945 T/5 Robert M. Cafarelli was killed in the Battle of the Ardennes Forest, otherwise known as the Battle of the Bulge, the last major German counter-offensive of World War II which was repulsed in January 1945. Rober Carafelli was 22 years of age.

His body is interred at Saint Catherine's Cemetery in Sea Girt, New Jersey. He was survived by his mother, Sophia, living in North Bergen New Jersey.
