PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION (Filed under Section 701 of the Nationality Act of 1940)

To the Honorable the District Court of the United States at Macon, Georgia,

This petition for naturalization, hereby made and filed, respectfully shows:

- (1) My full, true, and correct name is Bruno Max Elze,
- (2) My place of residence at the time of my enlistment or induction into the military or naval forces of the United States was 40 W. Englewood Ave., West Englewood, Bergen, New Jersey
- (3) I was born on March 11, 1923, in Hamburg, Germany,
- (4) My personal description is: Age 20 years; sex male; color white; complexion light; color of eyes hazel; color of hair blonde; height 5 feet 9-3/4 inches; weight 169 pounds; visible distinctive marks Scar on ring finger of right hand,; present nationality German.
- (5) I am not married; the name of my wife or husband is _____ (6) I have no children.
- (7) I emigrated to the United States, its Territories, or its possessions, from Hamburg, Germany,
- (8) My lawful admission to the United States, its Territories, or its possessions, was at New York, New York, under the name of Bruno Elze, on November 21, 1927, on the Cleveland, as shown by the certificate of my arrival attached to this petition.
- (9) I entered the Army of the United States, on Feb 4, 1943, under Serial No. 32762502 and am at this time still in such service, serving honorably (or I was honorably discharged on _____).
- (10) I am not, and have not been for the period of at least 10 years immediately preceding the date of this petition an anarchist; nor a believer in the unlawful damage, injury, or destruction of property, or sabotage; nor a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government; nor a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposition to organized government. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the United States. It is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States, and to reside permanently therein.
- (11) Submitted herewith as a part of this, my petition for naturalization, are the affidavits of at least two verifying citizen witnesses required by law.
- (12) Wherefore, I, your petitioner for naturalization, pray that I may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America, and that my name be changed to _____
