

September 9th, 1944 a B24 Liberator bomber and its crew were on their way from Leucars base in Scotland to Norway.

The plane was loaded with weapon and equipment. The mission was to drop supplies to Norwegian resistance groups in the area near Buskerud.

The plane came to low and crashed right under the top of the mountain Skorve in Seljord. The cause of the accident is unknown, but one of the teories is that they had problems with ice on the plane.
