The Kamera Klub, under the direction of Mr. Trend, is composed of a group of enthusiastic amateur photographers.

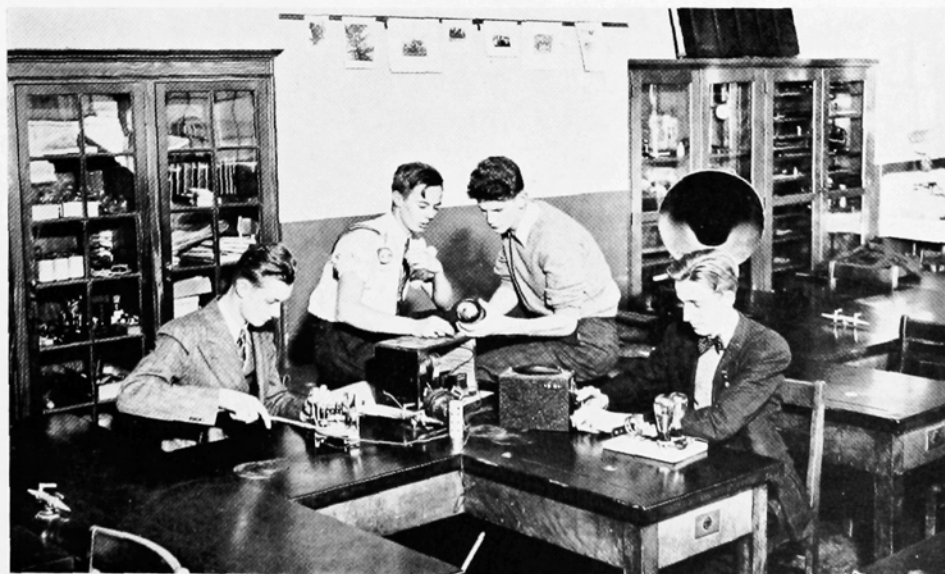
