ACTIVITIES: Football 11, 12; Track 11, 12.

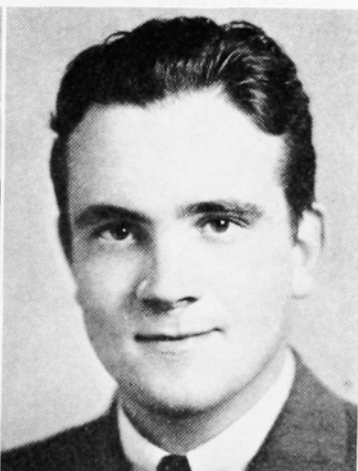
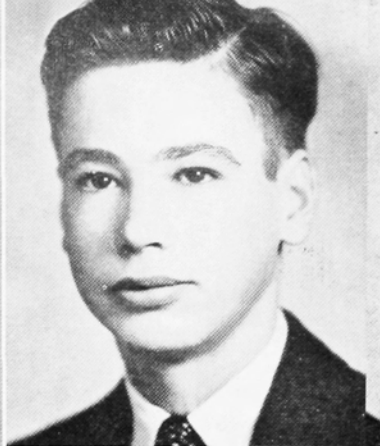
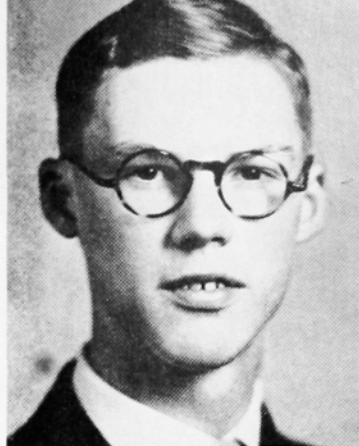
HIGHLIGHTS: "Reff" . . . good-natured . . . wish him luck in his coaching aspirations . . . "Reff" spends his spare time printing signs.
