

PHI DELTA THETA

The Phi Delta Theta Fraternity was founded at Miami University in 1848 and 35 years later the New York Beta Chapter was established at Union. In 1914 the Phi Delts moved from South College to the present chapter house.

The officers elected in the Fall of 1942 were: President, Don Giroux; Second Officer, Gary Jessen; Third Officer, Reggie Carroll. Fifteen members were initiated. In varsity sports Reggie Carroll represented the Phi Delts on the varsity football and basketball teams while Jim Quinlan was co-captain of the undefeated crosscountry team.

Twelve members have left for the armed services since last September. Members of Phi Delta deeply regret the death of Paul Santee, 1943, a member of Phi Delta Theta. He was killed in a plane accident while instructing pilots at Maryanna, Florida, in 1942. While at Union he was active in both intramural and intercollegiate sports, as well as a member of the Student Council.
