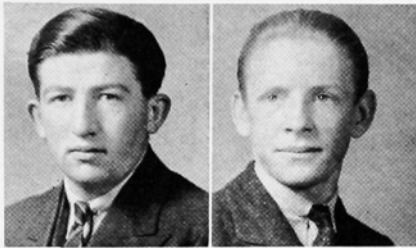


Hi-Way

"Red" . . . unworried and light-hearted . . . enjoys all kinds of sports . . . will become a bookkeeper . . . he is keen and persevering.

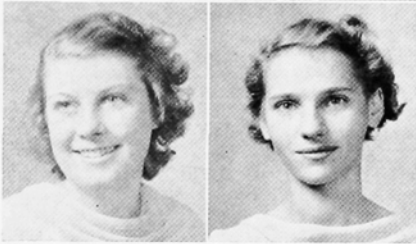


HARRY WALTHER
